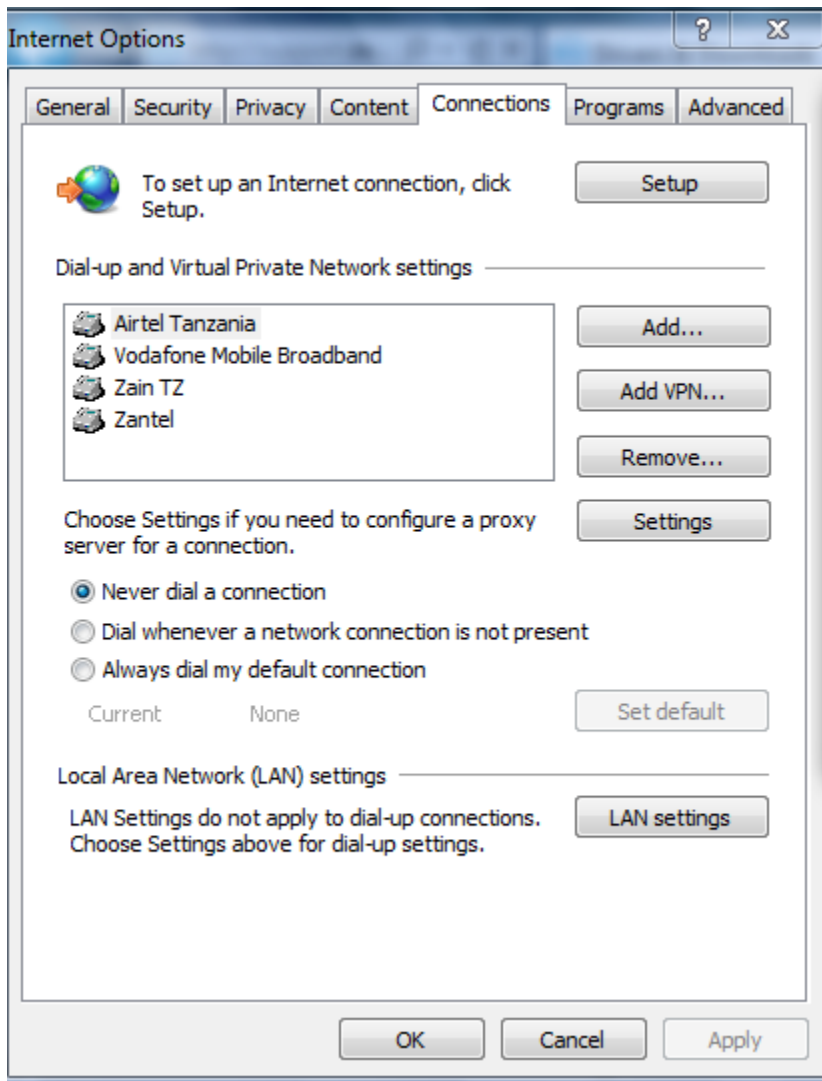

Browser proxy settings

How to configure proxy settings Internet Explorer (IE)

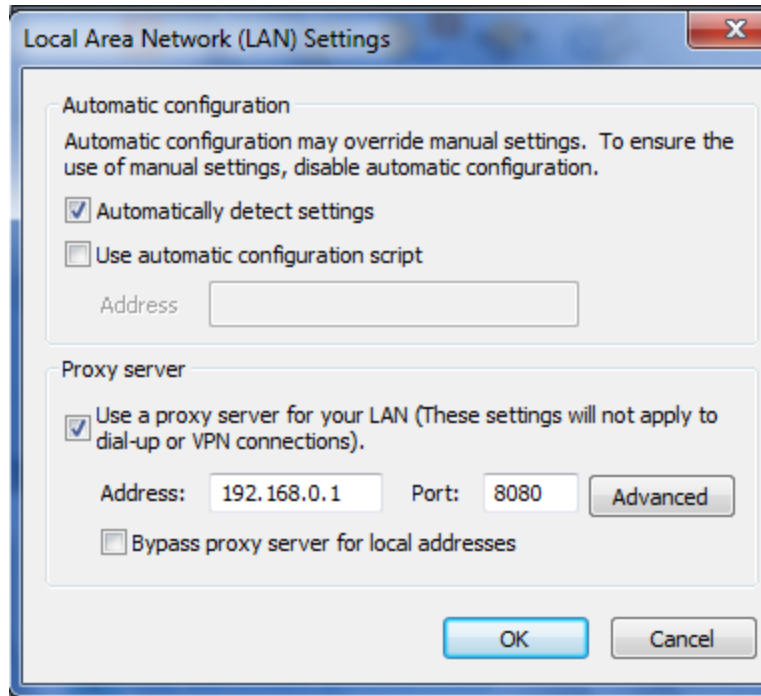
Open the Browser, Select *Tools* and then Click *Internet Options*.
Click the *Connections* tab.



Click the *LAN Settings* button.

In the 'Proxy Server' area, select the *Use a proxy server for this connection* or *Use a proxy server for your LAN* check box.

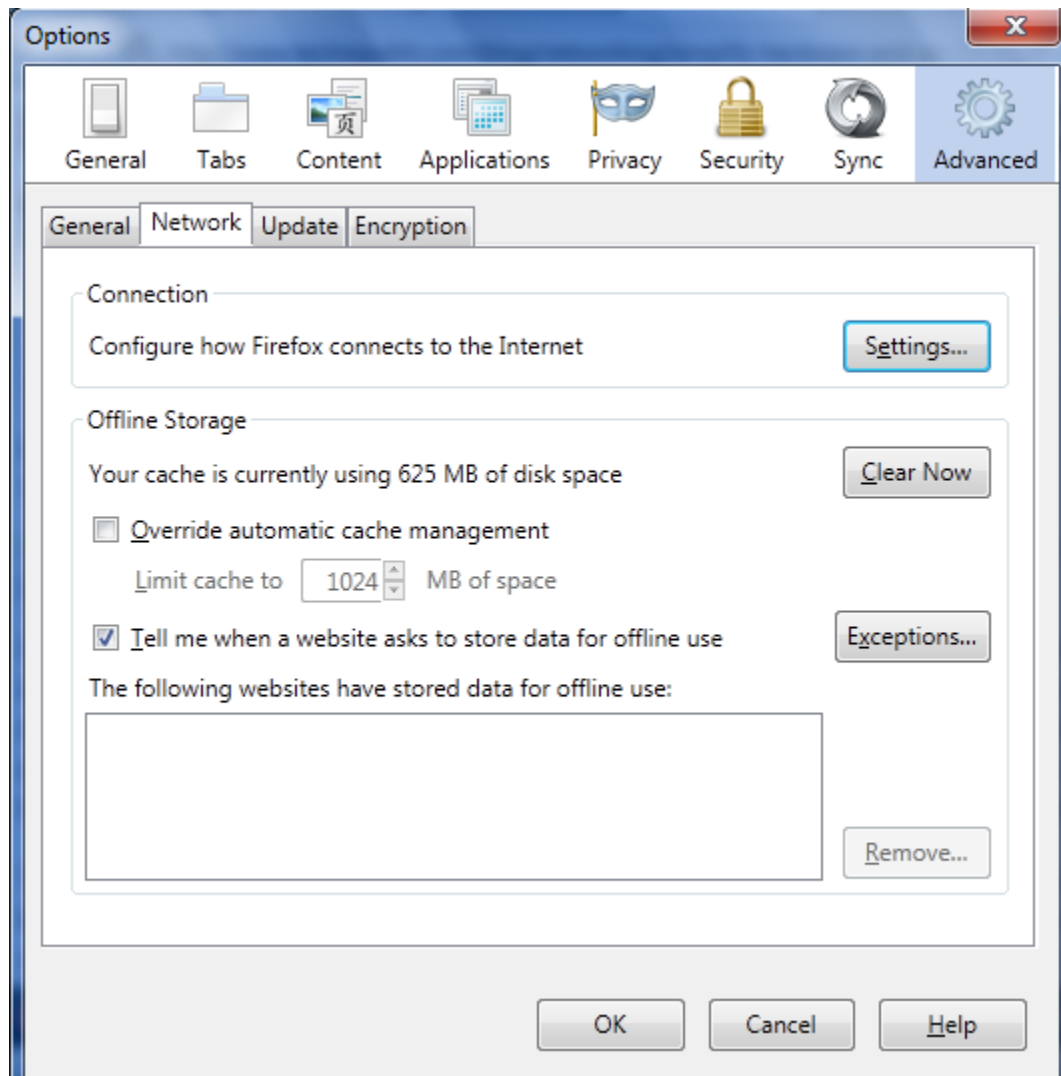
In the Address box, enter the address of the proxy server **192.168.0.1**. In the Port box, type the port number **8080**.



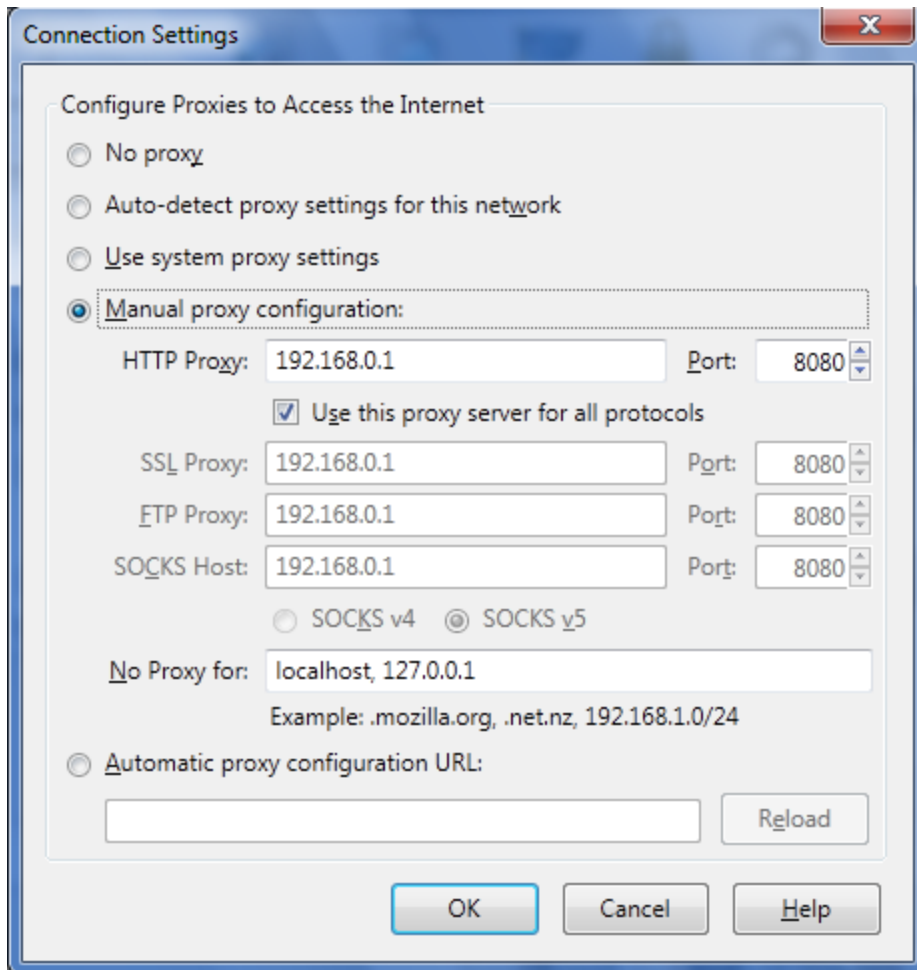
If necessary, enable the '*Bypass proxy server for local addresses*' option. Click OK.

How to configure proxy settings in Firefox

Open the browser, Select Tools and then Click Options.
Click the Advanced tab.



Open the Network tab.
Click the Settings button in the Connections area.



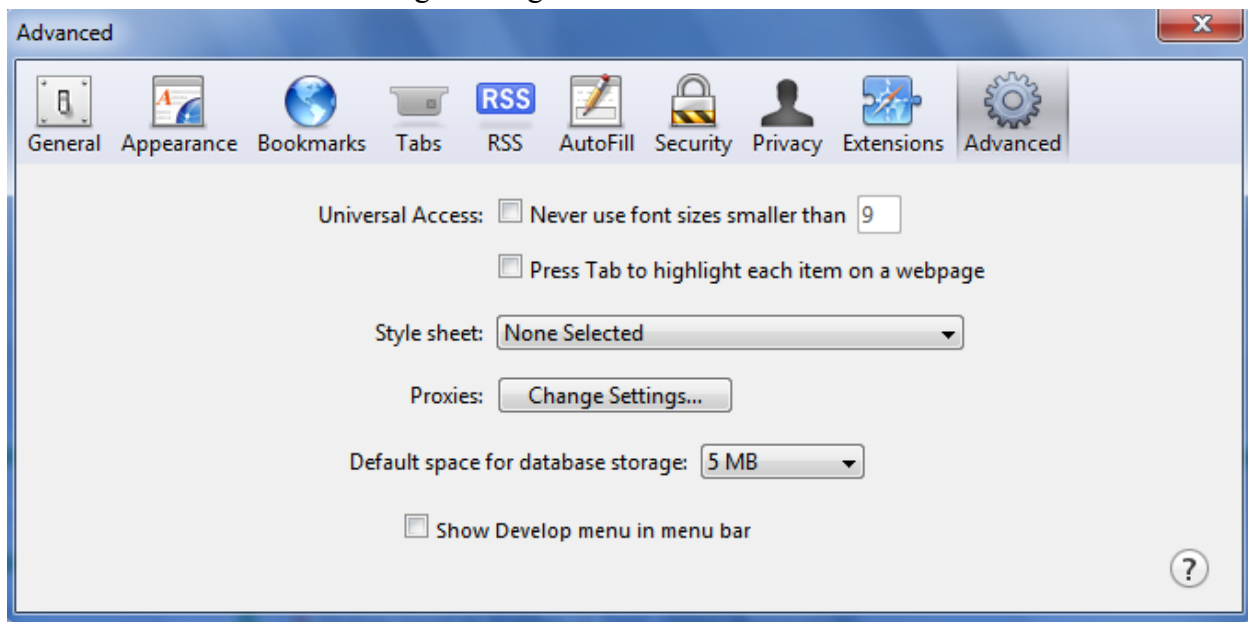
Select Manual Proxy Configuration.

In the necessary proxy field(s), enter the proxy address **192.168.0.1** and port number **8080**.
Click OK.

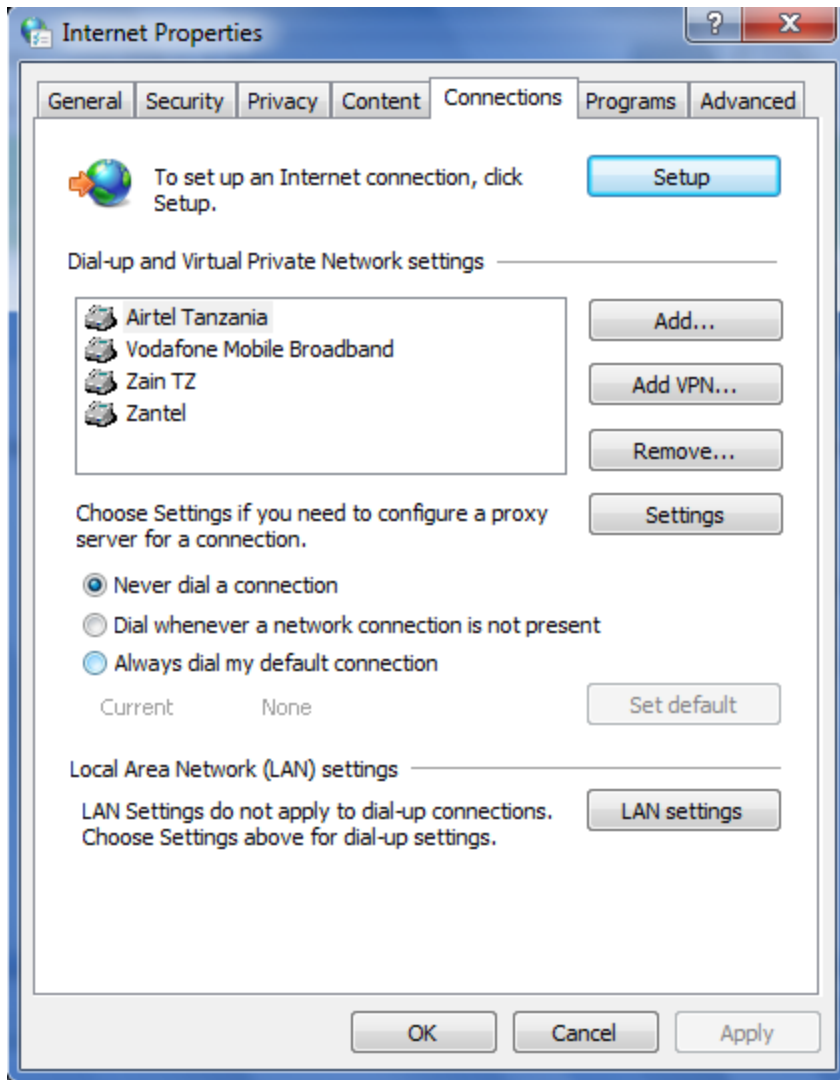
How to change proxy settings in Safari

Select Edit and then Preferences.

Click Advanced and then Change Settings.

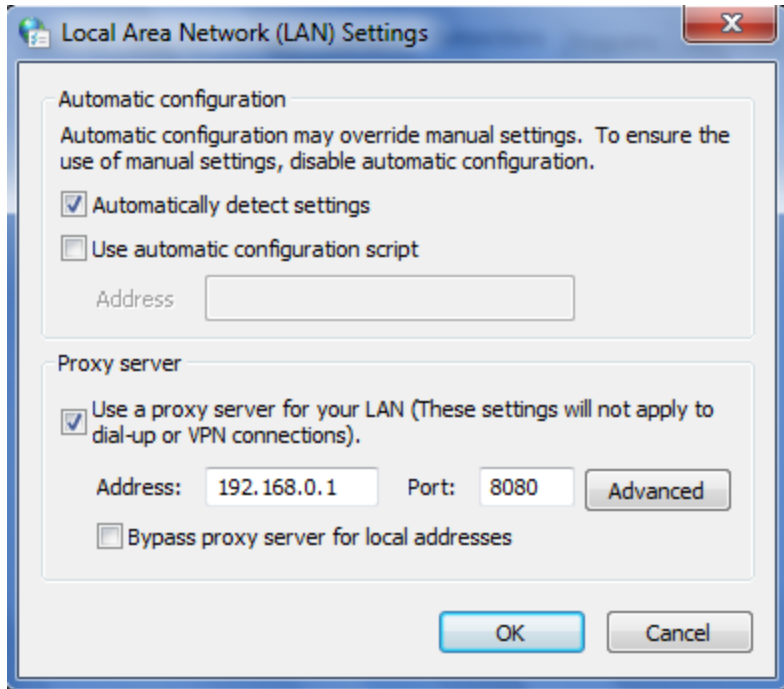


Click the LAN Settings button.



In the 'Proxy Server' area, select the Use a proxy server for this connection or Use a proxy server for your LAN check box.

In the Address box, enter the address of the proxy server **192.168.0.1** . In the Port box, type the port number **8080**.



Click OK.

How to change proxy settings in Opera

To change proxy settings:

Select Tools => Preferences.

Open the Advanced tab and select Network sub-category.

Click the "Proxy servers" button.

In the necessary proxy field(s), set the Proxy Server address **192.168.0.1** and proxy configuration port **8080**.

Click OK.
